HOW TO FIND US

23 Kensington Square, London W8 5HN

Heythrop College is situated in Kensington Square, the oldest garden square in London, only a short walk away from bustling Kensington High Street.

TRAVELLING TO HEYTHROP COLLEGE

Access to the main entrance at 23 Kensington Square, London W8 5HN:

By tube

The nearest tube station is High Street Kensington which is on the circle and district lines. To plan your journey, visit the Transport for London website: www.tfl.gov.uk

By bus

Access to the rear entrance at South End, London W8 5BU:

By car

Parking onsite is strictly by prior arrangement only. Access is via the rear gate on South End, (not Kensington Square). From the A315 to the north (Kensington High Street), take Victoria Road then St Albans Grove to proceed to South End and avoid the various one-way systems in the vicinity. From the A4 to the south, take Gloucester Road, leading to Palace Gate Road, to join Kensington High Street and proceed as above.
